### Clocklands and Constable Land

### Stone Close

Tenders are invited by Polebrook Parish Council for the mowing and grazing Tenancy of 1.5 acres of land known as Stone Close for the period commencing 1<sup>st</sup> April 2010 and ending on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2010.

The Tenant shall be liable for maintaining hedges, ditches and boundary fences and will also be required to secure the site as necessary against his own stock. All weeds and docks are to be controlled by the Tenant. No access is to be formed into adjacent property. The maximum number of animals permitted to graze at any one time shall be limited to two and no bulls shall be permitted.

The Tenant shall indemnify the Parish Council against all claims for damage, nuisance or any other complaint.

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## INVITATION FOR TENDERS

### Polebrook Burial Grounds and Allotments

Tenders are invited by Polebrook Parish Council for the cutting and trimming of the ground around the graves and within the boundary of Polebrook Burial Grounds and of the grass footpath within the Polebrook Allotments.

The contract period will commence on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2010 and end on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2010.

The location of the Burial Grounds is on Main Street opposite the junction with Hemington Road. The area to be cut is at the rear of the churchyard extension and covers an area approximately 32 metres by 10 metres.

The grass footpath within the Allotments runs from the entrance gate in Kings Arms Lane to the gate to Stone Close field and covers an area approximately 100 metres by 3 metres.

The Parish Council may decide to request further cuts to be carried out during the period 1<sup>st</sup> November 2010 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2011, if conditions require. Any additional requested cuts will be charged at the same rate as for the period 1<sup>st</sup> April 2010 to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2010.
